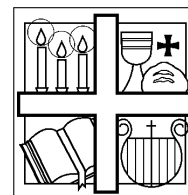
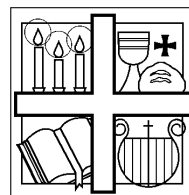
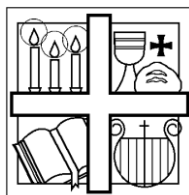
basket for donations (to assist with his extended studies). We are asking for donations for the **Silent Auction**; please bring them on the night of the **Potluck Dinner**.
