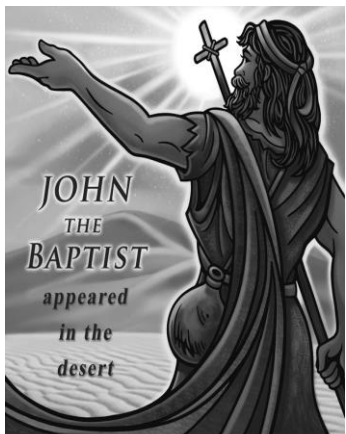
LECTURAS DE HOY
