TODAY'S READINGS

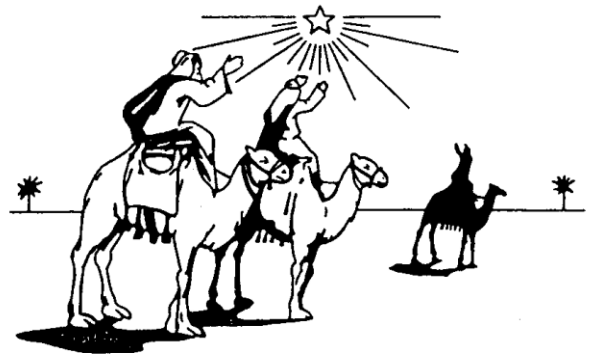
First Reading — Rise up in splendor, Jerusalem! The LORD shines upon you and the glory of the Lord appears over you. (Isaiah 60:1-6)
