Ordinary time, the time we are celebrating in the Church now, has two phases to it: a shorter period in the season of Christmas and the season of Lent. And then there is a longer period between the Easter season and the season of Advent. The entire ordinary period of the Church runs for thirty-three or thirty-four weeks, depending on when Easter falls. It is given the name *ordinary* because there is no particular moment or aspect of the Christian mystery that is celebrated.
