Father George's Did You Know?

The word "Eden" means *prairie* or *steppe*. In the Old Testament, it refers to a place of happiness and immortality. Adam and Eve enjoyed God's garden for a while but because of their sin, were banished from it. Scripture sets this Garden of Eden in the east. It is described as fertile land filled with beautiful trees. From it, four rivers flowed: the Pishon, the Gihon, the Tigris and the Euphrates. The general consensus is that Eden was located somewhere in what is now modern day Armenia.
