Father George's *"Did You Know?"*

The penitential rite of the Mass is not to be confused with the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Lacking sacramental absolution, it is to be understood as a preparatory time and an optional rite, wherein the assembly is asked to reflect on its spiritual condition, and praise God for his mercy. This time in the Mass can, and is, replaced from time to time with a sprinkling rite, where the people are sprinkled with holy water. This rite recalls for us the cleansing waters of baptism as well as tears of repentance. Maybe this is why there are so few people at confession, perhaps they think their sins have been forgiven in the penitential rite at Mass but sadly, they are not. That's why the Church schedules confession times.

**YEAR OF MERCY**

God, who is merciful, desires our mercy. Here are some ways to keep to mercy during the Jubilee Year. Try selecting one each week and putting it into practice.

1. Give away something of yours (that you really like) to someone you know who would enjoy it.
2. Pray a Divine Mercy Chaplet as you are traveling to or from wherever.
